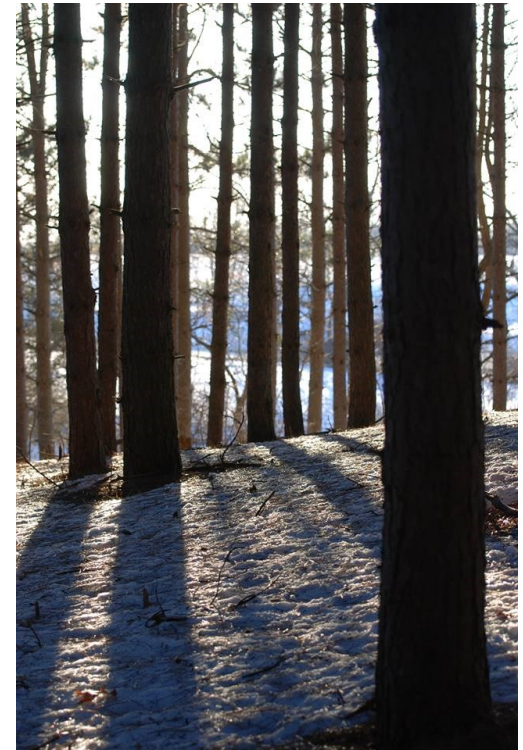

located on 300 acres of farm and forest
bordering Stewart Lake near Delton
Michigan.

garden, and milk a few goats.

Jamboree music festival, maple syrup
and apple cider weekends, Spanish im-

CPC grew out of the Ashland Folk
School, a pioneer experiment in educa-
tion for cooperative democracy,.

Membership is open to all who agree
with our aims and purposes. Govern-
ment of the organization is democratic
with two annual membership meetings
and an elected board of directors.



The lifetime membership

fee for each individual is \$400. Pay-
ment may be started with an \$80 down
payment. A yearly installment of \$40 is
due each October 1, and must be paid to
maintain active membership privileges.
The initial membership may be paid off
in \$20 increments for students/low in-
come. Payment of annual dues is also
required of all members in order to
maintain an active status.

Dues

Currently dues are \$100 for supporting
members, \$50 for standard members,
and \$25 for low-income or student
members. For members who wish to not
volunteer, the dues rates are \$150, \$75,
and \$37.50. Dues do not accrue from
one fiscal year to the next, but do impact
all member privileges.

Membership privileges

The right to vote (minimum age is 14)
and access to financial records
and reports
Subscriptions to all center publications
A discount on fees
Access to property without a
grounds fee

Membership duties

Members are expected to con-
tribute time and skills to the center--a
minimum of 12 annual volunteer hours
including workbees clearing trails, gar-
dening, and construction.
